The Official Statement is dated **April 2, 2020** (the “Official Statement”). The **County of Suffolk**, New York (the “**County**”) has prepared this Supplement dated **May 7, 2020**, to the Official Statement (the “Supplement”) to provide information regarding the **White, Samuel v. County of Suffolk, Suffolk County Police Department, et al.**

Other than with respect to the information provided herein, this Supplement is not otherwise updating the Official Statement, which speaks as of its date. Capitalized terms used herein and not otherwise defined have the meanings given to such terms in the Preliminary Official Statement.

The following paragraph is added under the heading “LITIGATION” as follows:

White, Samuel v. County of Suffolk, Suffolk County Police Department, et al.: A notice of claim and Federal complaint were served on the County alleging, inter alia, false arrest, malicious prosecution and fabrication of evidence in connection with plaintiff’s arrest and prosecution for murder. Plaintiff was ultimately acquitted of the charges after a jury trial. Plaintiff alleges that his constitutional rights were violated by the actions of County Detectives and members of the District Attorney’s Office. Plaintiff spent one year in jail. It is the opinion of the County Attorney’s Office that the likelihood of this case having a material financial impact on the County is extremely remote.
